The Stromsburg Mayor and City Council met in Regular Session Monday, June 24, 2013 at 6:00 p.m. at the City Office. Members present were Jack Anderson, Doug Lamoree, Dennis Nuttelman, and Pat Powell, councilmembers; Nancy Bryan, city clerk/treasurer; Jim Norman, planning administrator/building inspector and nuisance officer; Jim Papik, city attorney; and Lenard Schaefer, public works director. Ken Everingham, mayor; was absent. Jack Anderson, council president, called the meeting to order and all present recited the Pledge of Allegiance. Nuttelman moved, Powell seconded, to approve the June 10, 2013 council meeting minutes. Anderson, Lamoree, Nuttelman, and Powell voted yes, motion approved. Lamoree moved, Powell seconded to recommend purchasing a model M8 scrolling cemetery directory from Windy Prairie Cemetery Directories and to split the cost between the current fiscal year and the next fiscal year. Anderson, Lamoree, Nuttelman, and Powell voted yes, motion approved. Nuttelman moved, Lamoree seconded, to adjust the Covenant Church's sewer rate to \$51.92 per month due to a water leak that has been repaired. Anderson, Lamoree, Nuttelman, and Powell voted yes, motion approved. Lamoree moved, Nuttelman seconded, to change the camp ground policy to allow seven free nights, to suggest a donation of \$15 per night for additional nights, to not allow unattended campers overnight, and to have the policy posted and envelopes available by the donation box. Anderson, Lamoree, Nuttelman, and Powell voted yes, motion approved. Nuttelman moved, Lamoree seconded, to approve the claims. Anderson, Lamoree, Nuttelman, and Powell voted yes, motion approved.
