The Stromsburg Mayor and City Council met in Regular Session Tuesday, November 12, 2013 at 6:00 p.m. at the City Office. Doug Lamoree, councilmember, was absent. Ken Everingham, mayor, called the meeting to order and all present recited the Pledge of Allegiance. Anderson moved, Larson seconded, to approve the October 28, 2013 minutes. Anderson, Larson, and Nuttelman voted yes, Lamoree absent, motion approved.
