- b. **Ordinance No. 1091** amending Section 1-204 and **Ordinance No. 1092** amending Section 1-203: Transfers the bond recording duties from the clerk to the treasurer, and expands the duties of the treasurer regarding preparing lists of all special assessments and collecting them.
- c. **Ordinance No. 1093** amending Section 1-301: Revises time frames in which elected and appointed officials must file bonds or insurance for the faithful performance of their duties.
- d. **Ordinance No. 1094** amending Section 6-434: Changing prostitution provisions to add the affirmative defense that the person was a trafficking victim; adding provisions regarding violations by persons under the age of 18 years.
