The Stromsburg Mayor and City Council met in Regular Session Monday, October 27, 2014 at 5:30 p.m. at the City Office. Nuttelman moved, Anderson seconded, to approve the Specially Designated Liquor License for the American Legion for an event to be held November 8, 2014. Anderson, Kelley, Larson, and Nuttelman voted yes, motion approved. Anderson moved, Kelley seconded, to approve the amended loan agreement from the natural gas department to the ambulance department for partial financing of the new ambulance. Anderson, Kelley, Larson, and Nuttelman voted yes, motion approved. Kelley moved, Nuttelman seconded, to approve the claims. Anderson, Kelley, Larson, and Nuttelman voted yes, motion approved.
