The Stromsburg Mayor and City Council met in Regular Session Monday, May 11, 2015 at 5:35 p.m. at the City Office. Members present were Ken Everingham, mayor; Lois Burke, Bobby Kelley, and Terry Larson, councilmembers; Nancy Bryan, city clerk/treasurer; Jim Papik, city attorney; and Lenard Schaefer, public works director/city supervisor. Dennis Nuttelman, councilmember, was absent. Ken Everingham, mayor, called the meeting to order and all present recited the Pledge of Allegiance. Larson moved, Burke seconded, to approve the April 27, 2015 minutes. Burke and Larson voted yes, Kelley abstained, Nuttelman absent, motion approved. Kelley moved, Burke seconded, to accept the April, 2015 police report. Burke, Kelley, and Larson voted yes, Nuttelman absent, motion approved. Dennis Nuttelman, councilmember, arrived at 5:53 p.m. Larson moved, Kelley seconded, to accept the March, 2015 treasurer's report. Burke, Kelley, Larson, and Nuttelman voted yes, motion approved. Nuttelman moved, Larson seconded, to approve the special designated liquor license for American Legion Post 132 for an event to be held June 19 and 20, 2015. Kelley moved, Larson seconded, to approve the special designated liquor license for RNL Bar for an event to be held June 19, 20, and 21, 2015. Burke, Kelley, Larson, and Nuttelman voted yes, motion approved. Kelley moved, Nuttelman seconded, to hire the following lifeguards: Alexis Eller, Morgan Mickey, Kaylen Miller, and Reggie Rafert. Burke, Kelley, Larson, and Nuttelman voted yes, motion approved. Kelley moved, Larson seconded, to accept the bid of \$19,000 for Lot 22 in the Elementary Park Subdivision from Stromsburg Home Builders LLC and to delay the closing on the lot for one year or until the house sells, whichever comes first. Burke, Kelley, Larson, and Nuttelman voted yes, motion approved. Bobby Kelley was excused at 6:45 p.m. Nuttelman moved, Larson seconded, to approve the claims.
