The Stromsburg Mayor and City Council met in Regular Session Monday, August 22, 2016 at 5:35 p.m. at the City Office. Members present were Ken Everingham, mayor; Lois Burke, Terry Larson, and Dennis Nuttelman, councilmembers; Nancy Bryan, city clerk/treasurer; and Lenard Schaefer, public works director/city supervisor. Doug Lamoree, councilmember; and Jim Papik, city attorney; were absent. Ken Everingham, mayor, called the meeting to order and all present recited the Pledge of Allegiance. Nuttelman moved, Larson seconded, to approve the August 8, 2016 minutes. Burke, Larson, and Nuttelman voted yes, Lamoree absent, motion approved. Jim Papik, city attorney, arrived at 5:36 p.m. Larson moved, Nuttelman seconded, to approve the Special Designated Liquor License for the American Legion for an event on September 17, 2016. Burke, Larson, and Nuttelman voted yes, Lamoree absent, motion approved. Nuttelman moved, Larson seconded, to approve the request from Lanny Nielsen to waive fees for removing utility services at 1001 Main Street. Burke, Larson, and Nuttelman voted yes, Lamoree absent, motion approved. The hearing for the request from Vayden Anderson to vacate Headstrom Street from 6th Street to 7th Street and to change the zoning from Residential to Ag Transitional on Lots 4-9, Block 1, and Lots 4-9, Block 2, Headstrom's 3rd Addition was opened at 5:38 p.m. The planning commission recommended denial of the request since there is not specific plan for the property. Nuttelman moved, Larson seconded, to deny the request from Vayden Anderson to vacate Headstrom Street from 6th Street to 7th Street and to deny changing the zoning from Residential to Ag Transitional on Lots 4-9, Block 1, and Lots 4-9, Block 2, Headstrom's 3rd Addition as recommended by the planning commission. Burke, Larson, and Nuttelman voted yes, Lamoree absent, motion approved. Burke moved, Nuttelman seconded, to approve the bid from Home 360 for new subfloor in the city office for the hallway and office areas that are tiled. Burke, Larson, and Nuttelman voted yes, Lamoree absent, motion approved. Nuttelman moved, Larson seconded, to approve the claims. Burke, Larson, and Nuttelman voted yes, Lamoree absent, motion approved.
